Lieber Leser, liebe Leserin,
Dear Reader,

Weniges hat die Arbeit der Wirtschaftsforschungsinstitute so verändert wie die Aufgabe, in internationalen Journalen mit *peer-review*-Verfahren zu veröffentlichen. Diese Aufgabe zu erfüllen fällt nicht leicht, aber sie ist wichtig und zielführend. Inzwischen bildet sie in vielerlei Hinsicht den Kern der Forschung am DIW Berlin. Durch die erfolgreiche Orientierung am Standard der Journale zeigt das Institut seine fachliche Stärke, wird im Kollegenkreis immer sichtbarer, belegt die Aktualität der Forschung, zieht guten Nachwuchs an. Im Jahr 2010 wurde die Höchstmarke der Veröffentlichungen in SSCI-Journalen ein erneutes Mal übertroffen. Die Qualität der gelisteten Journale steigt ebenfalls.
